“The Way,” is a 12 week course which introduces and deepens for participants an Eastern Orthodox understanding of the essentials of Christian faith. Created and sanctioned under the authority of the Institute for Orthodox Christian Studies in Cambridge, England, it has been taught all over the world and has proven to be highly successful because of its emphasis on small group discussion and a shared meal followed by an opportunity to ask questions of Fr. Andrew and other local Orthodox clergymen. Each session includes a light meal, a talk, group discussion, a question-and-answer session, and the opportunity for fellowship and community with other participants.
